



GMAT/GRE Information

Waiver Requests for Executive MBA candidates

Candidates who have successfully earned an advanced degree (doctoral or masters) and/or those with ten or more years of strong career progression are generally granted a waiver of the GMAT/GRE requirement. To request a waiver, candidates should enter **WAIVER REQUEST** in the GMAT test date field of the application.

Candidates whose transcript(s) and/or work experience do not demonstrate sufficient quantitative or academic preparedness, and/or those with less than ten years of post-undergraduate career success are generally required to submit a strong GMAT or GRE score to be competitive in the admissions process.

Any applicant whose waiver request is not approved will be contacted and encouraged to submit a GMAT/GRE score prior to receiving an admission decision.
